Robert (Bob) Stankiewicz Oscoda County EMS Director –Presented details on EMS Millage Renewals and discussed 911 Surcharge Proposal that will be on the ballot August 4th.

Pickle Ball Club (Lynn & Sonja Handrich) – Presented a quote to the board for fencing to be placed down the middle of the tennis courts to accompany the quote for two permanent pickle ball courts given to the board in May. Cost is \$1620 for fencing and \$25,000 for the surfacing, installation of nets and painting. No action taken, but if the Board wishes to continue bids will need solicited and RFB published.

- 2. Discussion on proposal for pickleball courts to be upgraded at Boney Park. Board wishes to invite pickleball club to speak about their needs at June's meeting. Quote was for \$25,000 to resurface court and add permanent post.***
- 3. Quotes presented from Dinges Fire Company for boots, gloves, helmets and three sets of turnout jackets/pants totaling \$19,078. Funding would come from \$4,999 grant match received through the DNR and \$10,000 from the Fire Departments checking account that holds funds received through powerline invoicing, swimming pool fills and structure fire invoicing.***

✓ ***Salsbury/Barajas Motion to approve quote from Dinges Fire Company to purchase PPE for \$19,078 plus shipping. Utilizing the remaining balance of the Fire Equipment Millage funds, \$10,000 from Fire Checking and the remaining from General Savings.***
