Discussion: Supervisor Rob Murphy

1. Town Square Parking lot has made tons of progress but after the retaining wall is anchored it will require additional excavating work and gravel. Electric install will begin this week.
2. The new volleyball courts will need additional funds to add the rest of the sand, the original \$2,000 will not cover the cost.
3. Milfoil 2023 removal is scheduled for July/August. Trustee Dave Yoder expressed interest in doing the work himself with budgeted money allowing him to hire help.
4. Playhouse Structure will be placed at Boney Park by the putt-putt coarse and not the Town Hall, Deputy Clerk Amanda Barajas to redirect funds to come from proper account.
5. 15-inch solar speed signs for the East and North side of town have been ordered.
6. Potential to acquire more shares of Steiner Museum from Oscoda County and other townships. Comins Township would consider with more information.
7. Clerk Kelly Wangbichler and Deputy Clerk Amanda Barajas requested permission to look further into cemetery software with mapping, will bring final quote and information to the Board in July.

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8. *The audit final report for fiscal year 2022-2023 has been received. Board members to review and be ready to discuss at the July meeting.*
9. *Contract with GFL needs to be changed for May-September to increase from two pick ups to four. The dumpster has been overflowing.*
10. *Kubota repairs totaled at \$1250 for a new drive shaft assembly.*
